

## COLVILLE TRIBAL EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

CTEAP – Higher Education P.O. Box 150 Nespelem, WA 99155 (509) 634-2779

The following are the two programs that fund the CTEAP-Higher Education Department grants.

Higher Education: Funds <u>enrolled</u> Colville Tribal members attending full time at either a two or four year college or university. The student must be pursing a Liberal Arts degree, Associate of Arts (AA), Associate of Fine Arts (AFA), Bachelor, or Graduate degree. The funding varies according to the student's financial need.

CTEAP (Colville Tribal Education Assistance Program): Funds <u>enrolled</u> Colville Tribal members attending on a full or part time basis. The award is based on the institution's budget and financial need. The student can be enrolled in either a liberal arts or vocational program. No Correspondence courses will be funded. Vocational students with permanent residence off the reservation can be served through the CTEAP program.
