Amount: \$5,000 (1) & \$2,500 (2)

Quantity: 3 individual scholarships

Application Deadline: April 3rd, 2023 (Must be postmarked by this date)

Disbursement: June 2023

This award winner will demonstrate knowledge in current world science issues, academic commitment, and a strong sense of community. Award will be dispersed for graduation in June 2023.

- *1st recipient: \$5,000 – applicant will fully meet requirements*
- *2nd recipient: \$2,500 – applicant*
- *3rd recipient: \$2,500 – applicant*

Eligibility for Award:

- A graduating high school senior at Lake Roosevelt, Omak, Keller, Inchelium, Tonasket, Almira/Coulee-Hartline, or Wilbur/Creston-Keller High Schools.
- 3.2 accumulative GPA or higher.
- Applicant must have financial need.
- Plans to attend a 2-year technical school or 4-year university.
- Applicant must have 20 hours of completed and documented community service.

Award amount considerations:

- Preference will be given to enrolled Colville Tribal members, descendants, and other Tribes.
- Preference will be given to aquaculture majors or a related agriculture/science field.

Award Requirements:

1. Applicant must completely fill out the Pacific Aquaculture Scholarship Application and be legible.
2. Applicant will include their unofficial high school transcript in application packet.
3. Applicant will fill out the attached Community Service Hours Log and have it signed by their advisor.
4. Applicant must write a 1,000-word essay. Essay is not to exceed 1,000 words.
 - a. 500 words need to be dedicated to a current science topic in the news. Discuss importance of the topic, both sides of the issue and your opinion.
 - b. The remaining 500 words will need to be dedicated to the following:
 - i. Describe why applicant is pursuing a higher education degree, future education, and career plans.
 - ii. One paragraph to discuss the applicant's financial need and how this scholarship would help them.
 - iii. Describe your community service involvement and discuss why that is important.
