OUR MISSION:

The Colville Tribal Voc. Rehab. Program provide culturally appropriate Vocational rehabilitation services to federally recognized tribal members with disabilities. Individuals who have a functional limitation and need regaining employment. Services are regaining employment. Services are custom designed to fit each individuals needs.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE:

If you want to go to work and your answer is yes to the following statements, you may be eligible.

- Do you reside on or near the boundaries of the Colville Indian reservation?
- Are you an enrolled member of a federally recognized tribe?
- Do you have a physical or mental impairment that results in a substantial impediment to employment.
- Are you willing to work on a plan that will help you find suitable employment.

What is a Disability; A "disability" can be physical, mental, learning, or emotional condition that constitutes or results in a substantial impediment to employment. The following are examples of some "disabilities".

- Mental Health Diagnosis
- Hearing/Vision Loss
- Diabetes, Asthma, Arthritis
- Cancer
- Chemical Dependency
- Learning Disability

If I am Eligible; The next step is:

You meet with your assigned Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor to complete the intake process. Your counselor will work with you to develop a vocational, or interview sufficient information is gathered, and all services provided by Colville Tribal VR Program will be vocational goal developed in you vocational goal developed in you provided. Counseling and guidance services are provided. This Plan will document the steps that are necessary for you to attain your employment.



Types of Services provided:

A variety of services can be provided to assist eligible participants to prepare for, obtain, and/or to retain jobs. These types of services may include but not limited to:

- Assessments, Evaluations, and diagnostic services.
- Vocational and Technical services and devices.
- Job placement and retention services
- Post employment services
- Transitional Services

The services listed are based on each individual's needs and circumstances and are in accordance with an Individual Plan for employment (I.P.E.) that is developed with the client and his/her TVR Counselor.
